We hope to finish the translation checking of Proverbs in Lubwisi and Lugungu, and Psalms in Lunyole by the end of the year. The speaker populations of these languages are estimated to be 175,000, 100,000 and 630,000 respectively. They published their New Testaments 4-5 years ago. A mighty prayer to a mighty God would be to have the complete Bible in these languages plus Lugwere and Aringa by the year 2030.

If the Lord would see fit to answer that prayer, then Mary and I could gratefully speak words similar to Simeon who said, "Lord, now you are letting your servant depart in peace." (Luke 2:29) By then we will have served in Wycliffe for 40+ years and will be in our seventies.

For us to last that long, we need peace and love in our country and family relationships, good health, and so many other things—your continued prayers being chief.
